Introduction

Mazandaran in a Glance

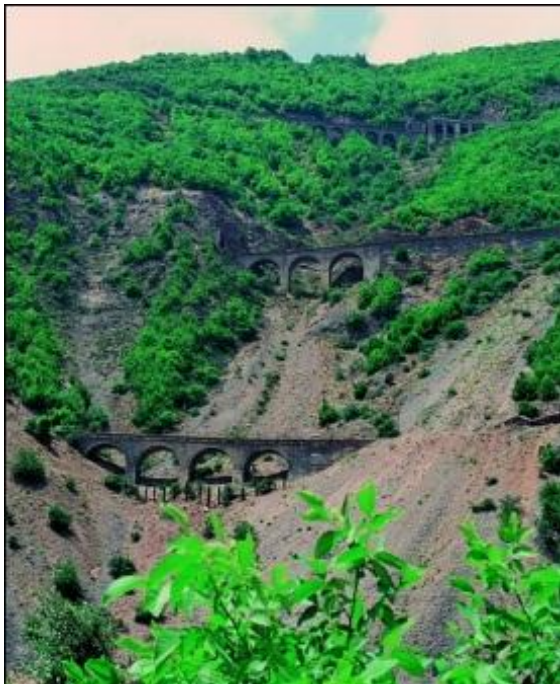
Mazandaran is one of the Caspian provinces in the north of Iran with total area of 23756 km² and geographical specification of 50°, 34' - 54°, 47' eastern longitudes and 35°, 47' - 36°, 35' northern latitudes. Located on the Southern coast of the Caspian Sea, it is bordered clockwise by Golestan, Semnan, Tehran, Qazvin and Guilan provinces (together forming Greater Mazandaran, separated from Mazandaran respectively in 1997, 1976 and 1960). Having total area of 438000 Km², Caspian Sea is considering as the largest lake in the world and one of the important aquatic ecosystems which including of 114 economic and non-economic fish species.

Its diverse nature and climate include plains, rangelands, and forests ranges from the sandy beaches to the rugged and snowcapped Alborz sierra with the highest peak and volcano throughout Middle-East and Western Asia, Mount Damavand which at the narrowest point (Nowshahr County) narrows to 5 miles and culminates less than 2000 meters from the coast.



A major producer of farmed fish in Iran and the neighbor regions, Mazandaran is the leading economic base of agricultural and fishery products. In other words, this province is the largest rice producer (43%) in Iran and has the first ranking in terms of cultivation area and production of citrus. Furthermore, benefiting from richest natural resources (Sea and Forest), unique ecology island (Miyankale Island), the only broiler production line and so many other characteristics, Mazandaran has been considered as the agricultural and natural resources province by Iranian governmental administration. Moreover, Mazandaran relies on the Tourism industry, as many tourists enjoy visiting the area.

Mazandaran contains a deep rich history with human habitation of at least 75,000 years. Recent excavations in Goher Teppe provide proof that the area has been urbanized for more than 5 thousand years of civilization, and this area is one of the most important historical sites of Iran and has played an important role in cultural flourishing and urban development of the region. Mazandaran was part of the ancient Hyrcanian Kingdom and former Kingdom of Tapuria. Indigenous people of the region are ethnic Mazanderanis (Tapurians), speaking a Caspian language.



Sari Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources University (SANRU)

History

SANRU University is located in the northern part of Iran and close to the Caspian Sea in city of Sari, Mazandaran Province.

The origin of university can be traced to the "College of Agricultural Engineering" which was established in 1974. This junior college was covering Agricultural Science, Forestry, Range management and Animal Sciences courses. In 1979, after victory of Islamic revolution in Iran, this college played a key role in establishing of the University of Mazandaran. At the end 1998, due to outgrowing of the college, it was authorized by the ministry of science to establish two new faculties; Agricultural Science and Natural Resources. These faculties started their official educational activities in 2000.

In 2004, the college was further expanded to four faculties of Crop Sciences, Agricultural Engineering, Animal Sciences and Fisheries and Natural Resources and it was renamed to "Sari Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources campus" based on both quantitative and qualitative development.

Furthermore, considering Mazandaran province as an agro-economic center, two other research institutes was added to this university, known as;

❖ Genetic and Agricultural Biotechnology Institute of Tabarestan (GABIT)

This research institute is located at the core center of the University and rather than having its own management system and independent organizational chart, it is included of several active academic subdivision such as Biotechnology, Agronomy and Plant Breeding.

❖ Caspian Ecosystems Research Institute

This research institute is highly active in term of conducting several research studied in different fields such as Forest Ecosystems, Marine Ecosystems, Ecosystem Products, Rangeland Ecosystems, and Environmental Issues.

Ultimately, in 2008, Sari Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources University officially announced its present legal entity. Today the SANRU has four faculties, more than 130 academic staffs, 3000 undergraduate (B.Sc.) and 421 postgraduate (M.Sc. & Ph.D) students.

The outlook of SANRU University is based on updated teaching, learning, research and innovation programs in order to prepare students, graduates and staff whom are ready to meet the challenges of the 21st century.

Higher education at SANRU University

Undergraduate honors degrees at SANRU University are usually four years in duration. Students are admitted to the academic faculty where their subject is offered. The degrees are structured to ensure a great deal of flexibility in the first two years of study, with students only confirming their major at the end of their second year.

Note: this is not applicable regarding to professional degrees which follow a less flexible curriculum.

At postgraduate level, Master degrees throughout the Iran I.R education system are two years in duration, whereas PhD programs are normally four years. An additional

benefit of higher education in the Iran I.R is the focus on the independent learning and research. This educational culture is reflected in the number of contact hours, which you may find to be slightly lower than your home country, and the expectation that students will be required to spend a significant proportion of their time doing independent study outside the classroom, driven in part by their own academic interests.

a) Undergraduate

We accept international qualifications from around the world. If Farsi is not your first language, we normally require that you achieve Persian score. This may be higher for certain courses.

b) Postgraduate

We accept international qualifications from around the world and will consider applicants with a good first degree (in some certain circumstances this must be subjected specific). If Farsi is not your first language, we normally require that you achieve Persian score. This may be higher for certain courses.

Computer and Internet Services

One of the vast services that has been provided by deputy of Research and Technology for all staffs and students is equipping the university by modern systems, software and hardware either inside the computer site or in staffs and academic member's rooms, in dormitories and elsewhere needed. Facilitating the electronic registry of students, automation of recording and other administrations services, automation of financial activities, automation of research and technology records, automation of all records in student vice-chancellery and automation of educational evaluation procedure and the key activity of this section.

Relation with Industries

Relation with industries is one of the most important sections which make a line connection between the university, specialists and industries to provide research needs of industries by applying academic staffs knowledge based on bilateral contractions between two sides. Definition of research plan in form of flagship contracts provided new activities between the university and industries countrywide.

Dormitory

Our dormitories consist of 300 bedrooms in four stairs at two separated blocks for male and females in a nice area inside the University campus. In each stairs there are facilities such as basic furniture, bed, washing machine, dinner table, carpet, fridge, iron, wardrobe, bookcase, desk, chairs, cooling and heating system, TV, etc. You may have a choice about the size of the dorm room you'd like to live in. If you choose a single room it means you will share it with only one person to try to meet a balance with; however there are four people in double rooms, two beds in each. Dorm rooms will be cleaned twice a week by the university cleaners.

Campus Environment

SANRU University is pleased to offer a complete education experience on a magnificent campus, with a modern library, modern classrooms, computer sites with highly efficient computer and internet connections, research labs, research centers, dormitories, student activity center, student sport complex, cafeteria and restaurant. The campus also offers bookstore, health center, Psychological Guidance, and ATMs. Students have the opportunity to participate in a variety of extracurricular activities and join a broad range of social and cultural events in the university. There are numerous activities to do including walking, tennis, basketball, volleyball, football, art, literature, music, folklore, photography and many more. Moreover, the students can watch films once or twice a week in a friendly setting and attend music classes.

Office of International Scientific Cooperation Office (ISCO)

The Office of International Scientific Cooperation Office provides information and assistance to international students, faculty members and researchers. It also establishes links between SANRU University and other Iranian universities on the one hand and foreign universities, research institutes and centers on the other. The ISCO offers advice and services to all international students and scholars. It provides opportunities for academic members and students to participate in international conferences, seminars and workshops. It also enjoys close relationships with many international associations and cooperates in offering its services for membership in international associations and sabbatical leave. Finance

It is important that you arrange funding for both your tuition fees and living costs prior to arriving in the Iran I.R. You should contact the Iranian Council Officer nearest you and governmental agencies in your home country as a first step for funding advice. In some instances loans given by your own Department of Education or by banks in your own country can be used to fund studies overseas.

Guaranteed Tuition Fee Rate

Tuition fees for international students are held at the level paid at the time of entry to the SANRU University to assist in budgeting for degree study.

Working part time

As an international student studying full-time for longer than six month, you are permitted to work for up to 10 hours a week during term period, provided it does not state otherwise in your passport. Please note this must not be relied upon as means to fund your studies.

Tuition fees

According to the decision made by the presidential board of SANRU University at 2015, the tuition fees (US Dollars) per each semester for each registered course at different educational level would be according to the below table;

Cost of living

The SANRU University recommends that you should consider approximately **\$400-450** for a singly student per month and about **\$800-850** for couples students per month as living cost in Mazandaran Province. Please note that the above mentioned values are only a very rough breakdown of costs. When you arrive at the University you can be sure of a warm welcome and there is a variety of events and services designated to help you settle into your new surroundings. This support continues throughout your studies.

Admission Requirements

Applications are evaluated on an individual basis. After their academic and educational records have been reviewed, applicants will be interviewed in person.

Application for Admission

An applicant for admission to one of the programs of SANRU University must satisfy the following requirements:

The applicants should present their high school diploma transcript or any other pre-university certificates that have been confirmed by the relevant authorities within or outside of Iran. Postgraduate applicants, in addition to the above documents, should also present their Bachelor's degree approved by the relevant authorities. Applicants who are not citizens of Iran are in addition required:

- To supply financial guarantees that sufficient funds for tuition and living expenses.
- To accept and observe all educational and behavioral rules of SANRU University

APPLICATION PROGRAMS

Applications are accepted twice a year.

Evaluation of your Application

As soon as your application is received; it is evaluated by the Registrar's Office. The result is forwarded to your e-mail. Incomplete application forms are not taken into consideration. The evaluation of an application normally takes a few days. An acceptance letter is e-mailed to the e-mail address of eligible applicants and reject letter to the applicant whose academic qualifications are not sufficient.

University and Course Registration

Students who are accepted at SANRU University are required to register on the given dates stated on the acceptance letter. For University registration students should go to Registrar's Office with the following original documents. Each applicant must fill and sign the Registration Form on the time of registration.
